GRADE 10TH

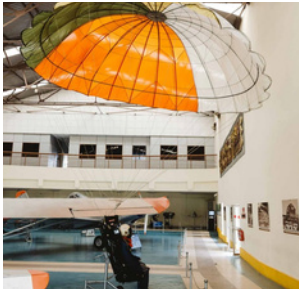

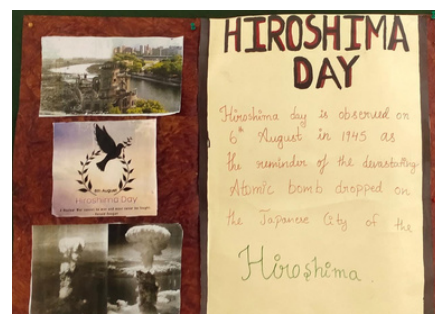

# HIROSHIMA DAY

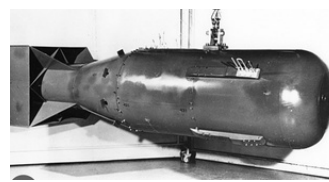

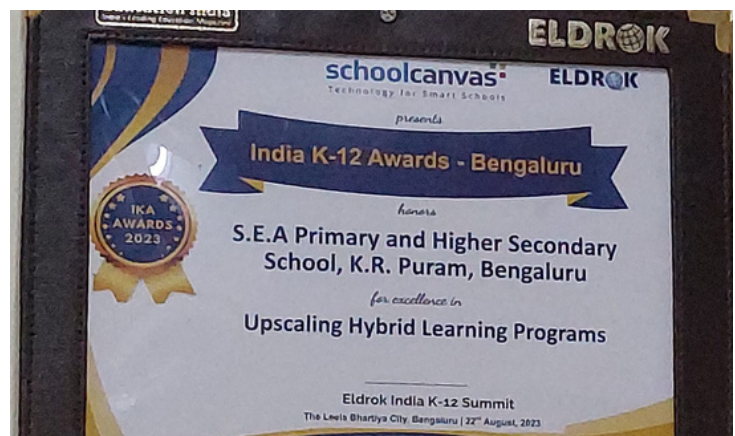
# ELDROK AWARD
